REMINDERS

BIRD FEEDER RULE

Bird feeders may not be placed outside of an area of 4 feet from the foundation of a unit, without written approval from the Executive Board, which may be revoked at any time. Bird feeders are not allowed to be placed or remain outside from May 1st to September 30th each year, except for jelly type oriole feeders, finch thistle feeders and liquid hummingbird feeders. No feeder may be located within 10 feet horizontally or vertically of another unit's open deck.
